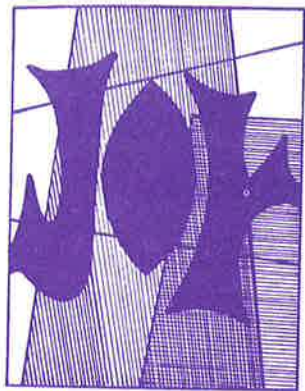


Tissue on Foil



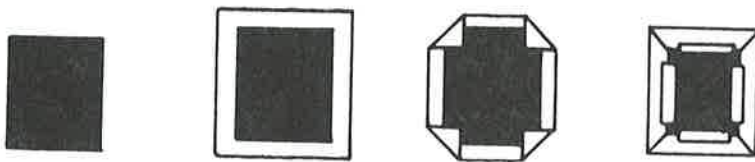
Technique: Tearing and/or cutting, applying tissue to other surfaces

Materials:

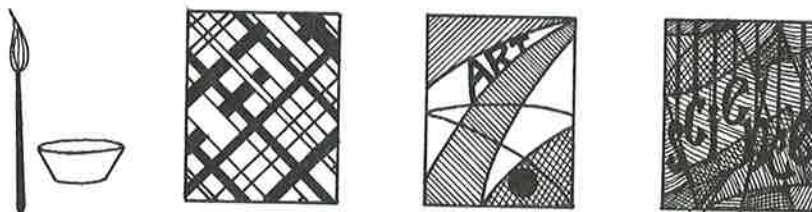
- 1 piece of cardboard or chipboard of desired size
- piece of aluminum foil, larger than cardboard
- scraps of tissue paper
- small container
- scissors and masking tape
- white glue and water mixture

Steps:

1. Lay the foil on the table, shiny side down. Place the cardboard in the center. Fold the corners of the foil over and secure with tape. Then fold the side and end edges over and secure with tape. Turn over.



2. Make a mixture of glue and water in the small container, two parts glue to one part water. Paint the entire surface of the foil with the glue mixture. Add tissue shapes, designs, or patterns, painting some of the glue mixture on top of each as it is put in place.



3. Finish by painting the entire surface of the decorated foil with a coat of the glue mixture. Let dry.

Suggestions:

- These make beautiful covers for notebooks.
- Try cutting Christmas ornament shapes from thin cardboard, covering with foil, and decorating with tissue—absolutely beautiful.
