

How to Make Ocean Art – Let's go Under the Sea!

Create a Rockin' Yellow Submarine!



Materials: colored paper: yellow, blue, red and any other color, black marker, scissors & glue.



Step 1: Take full sheet of yellow sheet of paper and draw a large circle along with the top of the submarine and the propeller.

Step 2: Cut out those shapes along with blue window, red port holes, blue rectangles for the ocean and some fishies, coral or any ocean animals you like.



Step 3: Take the black marker and add details around the windows and on the fish.

Step 4: Glue the shapes on the paper. Fold the blue paper back and forth to look like waves and just glue the ends on to the submarine. All done! Dive!

Paper Cup Fish



Materials: white cup, colored paper: any color, black marker, colored pencils or markers, google eyes, pipe cleaner, scissors & glue.

Step 1: Using crayons or colored pencils, color your cup, it will become the body of the fish.

Step 2: Take any half sheet of paper you have left and draw a big tail and two fins. Make the tail long, so that you can glue part of it inside the paper cup.

Step 3: Cut out those shapes along and glue the tail and the fins on your fish. Add the googly eyes.

Step 4: Have an adult poke a hole in the cup. Cut the pipe cleaner and push through the hole and curl on the outside. Splash!

Paper Bag Jellyfish



Materials: bag, colored pencils, google eyes, scissors

Step 1: Color the bag on all sides.

Step 2: Add the google eyes

Step 3: cut the bag and strips and you have a jellyfish puppet!
