Toilet Roll Binoculars



Materials: 2 toilet paper rolls, glue, scissors or hole punch, string and anything to decorate: markers, crayons, stickers, tissue paper, paint.

Steps- Connect the 2 toilet paper rolls with glue or tape. Poke 2 holes at top to tie a long string. Decorate how you like!

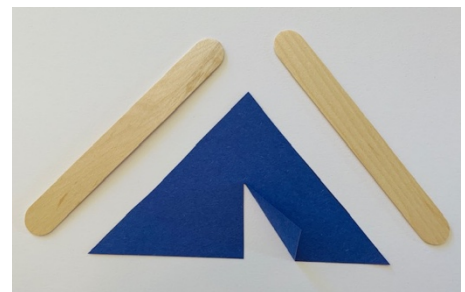
My Mini Campsite



Materials: 2 popsicle sticks, glue, scissors, different colored construction paper. (black, orange, yellow, brown)

Step 1- Create a Tent. Draw and cut out a triangle using any color you like, cut a line up the middle of tent, carefully fold over each side. Glue down tent then glue 1 popsicle stick on each side of the top of tent. Idea: glue a tiny photo of yourself inside the tent!

Step 2- Be creative! Draw and cut out anything you think of for camping! Trees, plants, campfire, stars, bears or other animals and glue to your campsite.



How to Build a Paper Campfire



Materials: Colored Paper- red, orange, yellow, brown and black, glue, scissors, wood skewer, Styrofoam peanut or marshmallow.

Step 1- Draw and cut out 2-3 log shapes from brown paper. Glue logs to the middle bottom of black paper.

Step 2- Draw a large fire shape onto orange paper- think round at the bottom, lots of points for the top. Cut out.

Step 3- Draw lots of random organic shapes with points at the top from the red and yellow paper. Cut out.

Step 4- Arrange the orange, red and yellow fire shapes on top of the logs. Glue down.

Step 5- Pretend you are roasting a marshmallow over your campfire! Use packing peanut and skewer, glue down. Or if you have a real marshmallow-use that instead!

Preschool/Kinder:

Cut out rectangles for logs and trace children's hands on the different colored paper for the flames!



How to Create a Nature Portrait



Using any piece of paper, draw the outline of your face. This example shows you about where everything should be, but you can draw it just how you like it! Gather items from nature, flowers, sticks or plants and glue it on as your hair!

Leaf Rubbing Collages

While you are outside, gather flat leaves. Put them underneath a piece of paper and color on top of the leaves with crayon or colored pencil. Look at the beautiful lines and shapes that you see!
