Corks






We put a couple of corks in your Kit. Make a butterfly or other creature with them!


Pop- Up Baby Duck

Materials: Colored Paper or White Paper Colored Pencils or Crayons, Glue, Popsicle Stick & Scissors





Step 1- Fold Paper in half. Draw an egg shape to fit within the half-sized page. Keep paper folded in half, cut out egg. Now you have 2 eggs.





Step 2- Draw a zigzag line across the top of egg to look like a crack. Cut off the top along the zigzag of ONLY 1 egg. **Step 3**- Glue the bottom part of cracked egg to the 2nd egg. Only glue around edges and leave a space at bottom of egg where there is NO glue. (this is where the stick will go.)





Step 4- Take a 2nd sheet of paper and fold in half, fold in half a 2nd time to create 4 equal spaces. Draw a baby ducky on one of the spaces.

Step 5- Draw a baby ducky and color how you would like. Cut out ducky.







Step 6- Glue the popsicle stick to the back of the ducky, only about one inch of the stick should be glued. Glue the top of cracked egg to the top of the ducky's head, like a hat. Step 7- Carefully slide stick through the space at bottom of eggs and finished! You now have a pop-up baby duck puppet!

Mother's Day or Any Day Pop-Up Card

Materials: Colored Paper, Colored Pencils, Markers or

Crayons, Glue, & Scissors





Step 1- Take 2 sheets of paper and fold in half. Cut one smaller around the edges, any way you like!





Step 2- Starting at fold of smaller paper draw 3 or more squares for the pop-outs. Cut outside lines of the squares and carefully fold to inside of card.




Step 3- Once folds are popped out on the inside then glue the back to the bigger paper.

Step 4- Draw anything you would like to attach to the pop outs. I chose flowers. Draw different kinds, sizes and colors. Cut out.

Step 5- Glue flowers to the pop outs, add others to background, color, add

details. Don't forget the front of the card! Write a sweet note if it's for Mother's Day or a note for your





How to Make a Paper Cup Animal



Use the paper cup in your bag to make one of these fun animals. Use construction paper and the colored pencils and the googly eye stickers!

How to Make a Clothespin Animal



Create any shape or animal you like using construction paper or any paper or cardboard material you have. Cut it in half. Glue each side onto the clothespin, making each side match. Add a special treat you will see when you open it!
